## Golf Memo #3: April 24, 2024

Another memo will go out next Wednesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, with more detailed information on postseason / hosting info / etc. Please make sure you are taking some time to read info sent out this time of year. We want to ensure everyone has the information and resources they need for a smooth transition into the postseason. **Regional Sites & Assignments** – will be released next week Wednesday (May 1<sup>st</sup>). They will be posted on the IGHSAU website under the Golf section and on social media. IGHSAU will set up all meets on Bound.

### Postseason Dates

- First Round Regional (1A/2A) May 10
- Regional Final (All classes) May 15
- State Tournament May 23-24

**Stat Entries on Bound** – Doublecheck all your stats are entered on Bound. BOTH team results and individual stats.

**State Coed Meet** – State Coed meet is June 3. **START TIME HAS BEEN CHANGED TO 10:00 AM** due to courses' request. Information and online registration link for the coed meet is located on both the IGHSAU and IHSAA websites. Coed meet is capped at 68 teams per class. Deadline for registration is May 27<sup>th</sup>. A list of teams currently registered can be found on the IGHSAU golf page.

**Regional Golf Roster Forms** – Regional roster entry forms are posted on the golf page. They must be submitted to the host school at least five days prior to the event.

**Postseason Practice Information:** Practice rounds are permitted anytime at regional and state tournament courses, prior to the first day of the regional/state meet. The IGHSAU does not govern loss of school time for Regional and State Tournament site practices, as this is a local school administration decision. Arrangements must be made with the course concerning time and regulations governing play.

**Postseason Admission** – There is no admission for regional golf meets. Admission for state meets is \$10 for all spectators kindergarten age and up. Tickets will be sold on Bound.

**Postseason Manual** – Postseason manual for all things regionals / state golf is posted on our website. Please start to familiarize yourself with this information as needed.

**Pace of Play** – Coaches, please continue to emphasize ready-golf with your team, ensuring that pace of play is not slowed.
