- ONLY PRE-PURCHASED ONLINE TICKETING AVAILABLE THROUGH VARSITY BOUND. No cash, check or credit card sales at the event!
- To expedite your entrance into the park please have your QR Code pulled up and ready to scan BEFORE you get to the park. It will be helpful to have only one transaction per vehicle if possible. It is also highly recommended to take a screenshot of your QR code at the time of purchase for ease of access!
- If you are sick stay home.
- The **FAN ZONE** is back again! An area in front of the clubhouse is dedicated to all the services you may need while at the state championships: program sales, official *State Cross Country* shirt sales from Fine Design clothing, picnic tables, port-a-potties and Hy-Vee food truck will all be in the "Fan Zone."
- Free parking available inside the park. The 1 private off-site parking lot will still
  be available for a parking fee. If using this lot, be aware that all exiting cars will
  be required to exit south. Please refrain from RV's or trailers if parking inside
  Kennedy. We are limited for space. To better serve our fans the following
  recommendations for arrival are as follows:

## 10:30 AM RACE TIME

- 7:30-8:30 am Race participants, school vehicles and busses
- 8:30-10:30 am Spectators

## 2:00 PM RACE TIME

- 11:00-12:00 pm Race participants, school vehicles and busses
- 12:00-2:00 pm Spectators
