Teams less than 125 miles from Coralville – \$1.25 per mile (1 way) & \$300 food allowance each day that you play.


 Teams more 125 miles from Coralville - \$1.25 per mile (1 way); \$300 food allowance & \$450 lodging allowance for each day they play.



#### **Team Check-In**


- Green State Family Fieldhouse Heidi Reed
- Bring two (2) copies of your roster (available on Bound)
  - One copy to Heidi at check-in / one copy to statisticians @ scores table
- 23 individuals on your bench. 10 chairs. 15 uniformed players.
- Day 1 plan to arrive 10-15 minutes early for a walk-around of the facility.
- Locker room / practice court access 90 minutes before your match
- Coaches will receive timing sheets for your match each day.
  - Team coolers no outside food allowed.

#### **Locker Rooms**



Locker room doors will be labeled with team's logo + informational sign

#### **Locker Rooms**

- Access to your locker room 90 minutes before start of your match
- Take belongings out of the locker room prior to your match
- Bag Drop Areas around the arena entries
  - Drop areas will not be monitored
- Teams will have opportunity to shower in their locker room after their match, if desired.
- Please be prompt in exiting locker room after your match so the next team can get in.



#### **Practice Courts**




- Volleyballs are provided. Will be at center of your practice court (20 balls)
- Take your cart of balls with you into Xtream Arena.
- Access given 90 minutes prior to the start of your match.
- Practice court coincides with locker room number.
- Available Sunday night, 4:00 –
   9:00 PM, in 1-hour time slots.
   Priority given to Monday's teams.
- Available Monday night, 6:00 9:00 PM, in 1-hour time slots. Priority given to Tuesday's teams.

### Players' Lounge + Media Space




- Players' Lounge + Hang space is located on the west side of Court 5.
- Head coach & players selected by media coordinator are required to report to Interview Space on Court 5 after their match.
- Local radio interviews can be done before going to the media space.

### **Team Seating / Arena Set-Up**



- Court 1 will enter through 111
- Court 2 will enter through 116
- Pre-match coin flip behind scores table of your court
  - Captain & Head Coach
  - 35 min before start of the match.
  - Used to determine first serve.
  - Visiting team (lowest seed) calls flip.
  - Highest (best) seeded team is home team.
- Team Benches (10 chairs)
- No more than 23 in the bench area. Extras will be moved to the seats behind the bench if you have more than 23.


## **Team Seating / Arena Set-Up**



- Introductions endlines.
  - Starting farthest from the bench:
  - Reserves (low # to high)
  - Assistant Coaches
  - Starters (low # to high) / Libero
  - Head Coach
- Pre-Match Handshake
  - Signaled by R1 after intros
- Non-Playing Team Seating beyond end lines
  - (109-110)/(117-101)

### **Spectator Seating / Student Sections**





- ADs and/or administrators will be identified by court managers prior to each match
- Home team crowds are behind team benches
- Visiting team crowds are opposite team benches
- Student Sections
  - 102
  - 108
  - 111 (110 overflow)
  - 116 (117 overflow)
- Cooley's Corner –
  Party Suite

# **Championship Thursday**

- Coaches will get a specific timing sheet for that day
- Introductions both teams will enter court through loading dock area (116)
- Fareway Serving Contest between sets 1 + 2
- Winner's Circle south side end of arena (101 / 117)
  - ADs assist with floor access @ 102/103
- Award Recognitions
  - Before 3A Academic All-State
  - Before 2A Hall of Fame
  - Before 1A Distinguished Coach Award

#### **Trainers**

- School trainer may sit on the bench if member of the 23-person roster.
- ATC provided by the University of Iowa.
- Training Room is in the middle of the locker room hallway, between locker rooms 2 & 3.
- On Court will be seated between the two courts by the curtain.
- Will be there 90 minutes prior to the first match of the day, through the day.
- There to tape / ice / evaluate. No access to modalities (STEM, etc.)
  - Specialty tapes (KT) must bring your own. ATCs can apply it.

## **Television and Web Streaming**

 Quarterfinal and semifinal games will be streamed live by CISN TV for the IGHSAU Digital Network. Links will be posted at the top of the IGHSAU website.

Iowa PBS will televise the championship games.

Coaches will be mic'd in the championship games.




