

## Girls' Golf Memo #3 May 12, 2017

**QuikStats Deadline:** The remaining mandatory reporting date is May 22<sup>nd</sup>. Coaches are expected to update their QuikStats throughout the Regional Tournament series. Stats should be updated the day following each Regional competition.

**Post Season Dates:** First Round Regional Golf – Monday, May 15 start times vary  
Regional Final – Monday, May 22 start times vary  
State Tournament – May 30 – May 31, 9:00 a.m. shotgun start both days

**Regional Entry Forms:** First Round Entry forms and Regional Final Entry forms are to be sent to the meet manager prior to the meet (7 days prior for First Round Regional and 6 days prior for Regional Final). Schools will be notified of the start time and other details pertaining to their Regional meet by the meet manager of the region they are assigned. Meet managers determine start times. A \$10/golfer green fee must be paid to the meet manager prior to the team's participation in the Regional tournament. Meet managers will let each school know of their golf course policy for outside food and beverage. **FYI...outside food and beverage will NOT be allowed at State Golf Tournament venues.**

**Regional Advancement:** The top two teams and top five individuals advance to the next level of play. Medals for the top five golfers (and those tied for 5<sup>th</sup> place) and State Qualifier banners for the top two teams will be awarded at the end of the Regional Final meet only.

**Team Competition:** If a team does not have four golfers, then that school would not be eligible to compete in the team competition, however their golfers can still be eligible for individual honors. **A fictional golfer and score should never be used to complete a team.**

**Players Sharing Advice:** Teammates and fellow competitors are not considered "partners" and thus cannot share advice with each other. All golfers are deemed competitors because they are competing for the medalist competition. Rule 8-1

PLEASE NOTE: Sharing advice does NOT include assistance in searching for lost balls, rule info and course info. A few advice examples that violate the rule are: club suggestions, golfing tips or advice playing a shot.

**Coaches please be reminded that coaching your players should not slow down play.** Being too hands-on can negatively impact the pace of the play.

**State Co-ed Tournament Tuesday, June 6:** Registration forms are on the IGHS AU and IHSAA websites. The fee is \$35/twosome and includes lunch for each golfer. Please be reminded that the number of registrations will be limited. **The registration deadline is May 31<sup>st</sup>.**

Class 1A Schools with BEDS 349 or below play at American Legion Golf Course in Marshalltown.

Class 2A Schools with BEDS 350 or above play at Coldwater Links in Ames.

### **State Tournament Course and Practice Information**

Practice rounds are permitted anytime at state tournament courses, prior to the first day of the State Tournament. The IGHS AU does not govern loss of school time for Regional and State Tournament site practices, as this is a local school administration decision. Arrangements must be made with the course concerning time and regulations governing play. **The rates below are for girls' high school golf teams and their school-appointed coaches ONLY. Family and friends accompanying the golfers for practice rounds will not receive the rates listed below.**

### **American Legion Golf Course in Marshalltown (Classes 1A) 641-752-1834**

Practice Round Rates: \$15.00 to walk. Carts are \$15/person

These rates are available all day, every day. **\*\*This is a site for the IHSAA State Golf Tournament. The course will be closed all day May 26 and until approximately 3pm on May 27.**

**Jester Park Golf Course in Granger (Class 2A)**

Practice Round Rates: \$15.00 walk. Carts are \$15/person

These rates are available all day, every day with the exception of Memorial Day weekend. The above Junior rate will only be available for tee times after 2:00 p.m. on Memorial Day weekend.

**Lake Panorama National Golf Course in Panora (Class 3A) 641-755-2024**

Practice Round Rates: \$15.00 walk. Carts are \$20/person

These rates are available all day, every day with the exception of Memorial Day weekend. The above Junior rate will only be available for tee times before 12:00 p.m. on Memorial Day weekend. Tee times may not be available after 12:00 p.m. on Memorial Day due to a tournament. Please call the Pro Shop for available tee times.

**Elmwood Country Club in Marshalltown (Class 4A) 641-753-8111**

Practice Round Rates: \$20 to walk. Carts are \$14/person

Players must reserve practice rounds through Jay Giannetto, PGA Professional.

The golf course will not be available for practice rounds on Memorial Day.

**Coldwater Golf Links in Ames (Class 5A) 515-233-4664**

Practice Round Rates: \$20.00 walk. Carts are \$15/person

The above junior rates are available weekdays and after 12:00 p.m. on the weekends and during Memorial Day weekend.
