

Dear Wrestling Coaches and Athletic Directors-

As we approach Regional Qualifying meets we wanted to reach out with some reminders.

- 1) TrackWrestling has updated the state seeding, you will need to check all your athletes' seeding criteria. You can do this by logging into your season team, going into your roster, click on the athlete's name, and hitting 'Seed Criteria.' Please check state qualifiers and state place winners from last year to make sure that reflects appropriately. This is extremely important if your team has any transfers or your team is new. - 2) Please be sure to keep all past weigh-in sheets for the season. If you have not been doing that this season, please be sure to do that from now on.
- 3) JV wins do not count toward your overall win percentage. Please do not try and use that argument within a regional seeding meeting.
- 4) If your athlete or coach receives an ejection, please make sure to reach out to Madison Melchert at madison@ighsau.org in the IGHSAU office. She will be able to help you through those steps. You can find ejection information listed on our website using this LINK.
- 5) The 2lb growth allowance has been made available as of December 16th. Reminder this is available to every wrestler. There is no more requirement to reach scratch weight. The 2lb growth allowance cannot be utilized to compete in a weight class that is lower than your decent plan allows.
