WRIST BANDS

Wrist Bands will be used for your admittance into Drake Stadium for the State Track Meet. Please pay close attention to the rules to prevent issues or removal from the stadium during the meet.

RULES

- 1. <u>Must be worn on the wrist at all times</u>. The band when placed on the wrist will not come off unless you cut it off. It is good for all three days of the state meet. A contestant must leave in on the wrist over night for stadium entrance on the following day.
- 2. <u>Ushers will not allow admission unless the band is properly in place</u>. You will be denied admittance if you do not have the band on your wrist.
- 3. Participants will not be allowed on the track or infield without the band in place.

 Do not remove the band until you are ready to leave the meet and not planning to return.
- 4. <u>In the rare occurrence that a band is damaged or needs to be replaced</u>, a coach may bring the band needing replacement to the hip number tent on the north concourse near the stadium scoreboard.

ADDITIONAL COACHES WRIST BANDS

Each competing squad will receive 4 complimentary wristbands for their coaches and managers. There is an opportunity for participating schools to purchase additional coaching wrist bands. **The only advantage in having this wrist band is having pre-purchased admission for each day**. Here are the guidelines for additional coaching wrist bands.

- 1. The cost is \$30.00. **Cash or check only**. Checks should be made payable to: Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union.
- 2. The wrist bands can only be purchased at the northwest gate.
- 3. You must present a letter from a school administrator authorizing the purchase.
